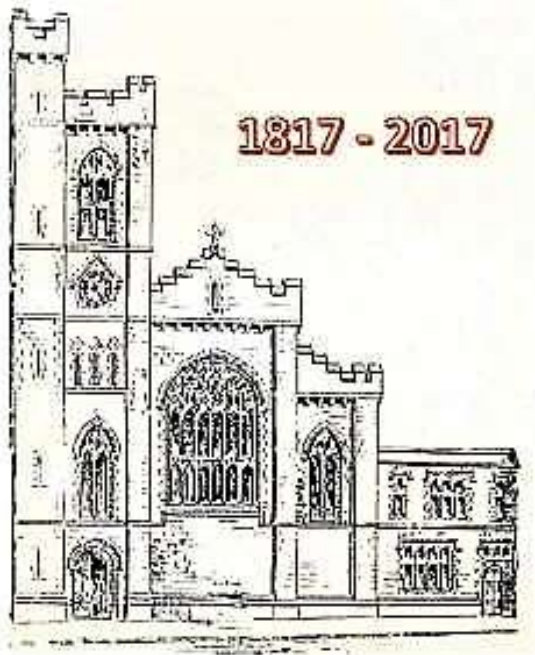

Greetings from the priests of the parish and the Parish Pastoral Council.

The parish of St. Michan in Halston Street was constituted in 1096 making it one of the oldest parishes in the diocese. We are fortunate to be living in such an historic part of Dublin, the significance of which can be lost on some as they come and go for business and other reasons.

There are two Catholic churches in our parish – the parish church of St. Michan (Halston Street) and the friary church of St. Mary of the Angels (Church Street). The parish is presently under the care of the Capuchin Franciscan Order.

During the bicentenary of St. Michan's Church in 2017, the restoration work continued, and we realised our hope to have the interior of the church painted except for the ceiling. We rely on the advice of the conservationists before undertaking such a big job. We are fortunate that we have been able to cover the cost of all work so far with funds raised through Conservation Grants, Heritage Grants, Bequests and extremely generous donations from a number of parishioners and friends.
