## Dublin's "Camino" for the World Meeting of Families

The World Meeting of Families 2018 Pilgrim Walk begins this Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> August and runs until Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2018. Archbishop Diarmuid Martin and Archbishop Michael Jackson officially launched the walk at 12 noon on Saturday, 18<sup>th</sup>, walking together from St. Michan's on Church Street to St. Michan's on Halston Street.

Pilgrims are invited, in a single day or over a few days during that week, to undertake the Walk. It involves visiting seven designated churches and spending time in prayer in each of them for a special intention for families before finishing the visit with the WMOF2018 prayer. Each pilgrim will be issued with a pilgrim walk passport which will be stamped at each church in the ancient tradition of the Camino of St James. A pilgrimage certificate of completion will be stamped when they arrive at the last of the seven churches.

The route for the Pilgrim Walk includes the following churches and themes:

- **St Teresa's, Clarendon Street** – *the gift of parents to the family.*
- **St Francis Xavier's, Gardiner Street** – *the role of teachers in enriching the children of our families.*
- **St Saviour's, Dominick Street** – *God walks with families when times are tough*
- **St Michan's, Halston Street** – *the gift of children to the family*
- **St Michan's, Church Street** – *fostering the gift of forgiveness among families*
- **St Audoen's Church, High Street** – *the gift of grandparents to the family*
- **Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Aungier Street** – *love at the heart of the family*

All churches will remain open each day between 9.30am and 7pm.

## Planning your trip to see Pope Francis

*Leave your car at home, public or private coaches will minimise the walking*

There is no car park near the Phoenix Park where attendees will be able to park up and walk to the Papal Mass. There are designated Park & Ride facilities so that walking is minimised as you make your way to and from the Mass.

Every bus, train and tram are being used for this event and for the safety of the travelling public. If you have a ticket for the Phoenix Park, you will be allowed to travel for free **within** Dublin on Sunday 26 August.

- 250,000 journeys available from Iarnród Éireann across Intercity, DART and Commuter services.
- Bus Éireann will be operating a weekday service throughout the country to bring people to the Papal Mass.
- Dublin Bus have created 7 dedicated Papal transport hubs which will take you in close proximity to the gates of the Phoenix Park. Almost 1,000 Dublin Buses will be available to get people to and from the Mass.
- Special Park & Ride hubs have been created in a number of locations where people can park up and then take public transport to and from the event. These are Leopardstown Racecourse (Luas), UCD Belfield (Dublin Bus), Maynooth University (train) and Fairyhouse Racecourse (train).
- The LUAS Red and Green line will be operating a 6-10 minute frequency throughout the day on Sunday, 26 August.
- Go-Ahead Ireland is providing 40 extra double deck vehicles on 26 August

For those travelling from outside Dublin, the National Transport Authority asks that people pre-book train/bus/coach.

## Controlled Access Zone around Dublin City from 6am until 11pm on Sunday 26 August



There will be a secure area around Dublin, starting at the M50 from 6am to 11pm on Sunday 26 August. If you are planning on using your car to access Dublin City on Sunday, 26 August then you should be aware that there will be diversions/road closures and other restrictions in place on the day. You will need to leave plenty of time for any journeys to and across Dublin City from 6am to 11pm on the Sunday, 26 August, and pay attention to restrictions in place on the day.

There will also be rolling restrictions on Saturday, 25 August as Pope Francis visits a number of locations in Dublin city centre, including the Capuchin Day Centre.

For those not attending the event, the NTA will also be operating all normal Sunday scheduled transport services. With road closures some buses will be diverted but customers will be informed of any changes to their route.

## ***Be part of the distribution of Holy Communion team at the Papal Mass in the Phoenix Park on Sunday August 26<sup>th</sup>***

As excitement builds around the final Mass of the World Meeting of Families 2018 at which Pope Francis will be our principal celebrant, **we are seeking the generous help of around 3,000 ministers of Holy Communion to volunteer for that one day** to be Christ's disciples helping to give the Bread of Life to the people at this historic event. **This is open to any of those who are already trained and assisting with the distribution of Holy Communion in their own parishes. We are looking for the help of lay people, priests, deacons and religious Ministers of Holy Communion.**

Those volunteering need to **BE ALREADY TRAINED AND FUNCTIONING MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION in your own parish community. You will need to be STEADY ON YOUR FEET.** Although there will be some plastic tracking laid down, much of the distribution will be done in the grassy corrals of the Phoenix Park Papal Mass site. You **will need to be GARDA VETTED for this event**, even though you have been vetted for this ministry in your own parish. [If you are already Garda vetted for WMF2018, that suffices.]

**You will NEED TO BE IN THE PHOENIX PARK BY AROUND 10.30AM on SUNDAY 26<sup>th</sup> August** so as to be walked through how and where you will minister. It may not be possible for you to be assigned to minister in the place where your family or fellow parishioners are situated, but we hope this won't put you off generously stepping up to help with this important task. And we will do our best to keep parish groups working together.
